CONDUCTING HINDI LANGUAGE CLASSES**

The Consulate General of India, Seattle is inviting applications for the post of "**Local Resource Person for conducting Hindi language classes**" at the Indian Consulate. The post will entail conducting regular Hindi classes (at least three classes of Hindi language per week to begin with) at the consulate premises.

Please note that the remuneration for the Hindi Teacher position will be regularized in accordance with the prescribed rates set by the Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India.

Required qualifications and skill set:

- Candidates must possess a minimum of a three-year degree coupled with three years of practical experience, **or** a two-year diploma/certificate **or** equivalent training in the relevant field, acquired over a minimum period of two years from a reputable institution.
- Proficient communication abilities in the English & Hindi language.
- Valid work permit (EAD/permanent residency (Green Card)/ USA citizen).

Desired qualifications and skill set:

- Experience in teaching of Hindi language.
- Comprehensive understanding of computer operations, encompassing audio/video recording and downloading, as well as video mixing and editing from online platforms such as YouTube and the internet.
- Demonstrated experience in delivering performance and lecture demonstrations.
- Aptitude for producing stage programs along with expertise in examination preparation.
- The candidate should exhibit initiative and dedication towards assisting students in reaching their highest potential, maintaining high expectations for achievement, progress, and conduct.
