The Consulate General of India, Seattle is inviting applications for the post of "**Local Resource Person for conducting Indian classical music classes**" at the Indian Consulate. The post will entail conducting regular music classes (at least three classes of classical music per week to begin with) at the consulate premises.

Please note that the remuneration for the Indian Classical Music Instructor position will be regularized in accordance with the prescribed rates set by the Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India.

Required qualifications and skill set:

- Candidates shall **either** possess a minimum of a three-year degree coupled with three years of practical experience, <u>or</u> a two-year diploma/certificate <u>or</u> equivalent training in the relevant field, acquired over a minimum period of two years from a reputable institution <u>or</u> under the tutelage of a distinguished Guru, with a minimum of four years of professional experience.
- Thorough understanding of the history, philosophy, and traditions associated with Indian culture and Indian classical music.
- Proficient communication abilities in the English language.
- Valid work permit (EAD/permanent residency (Green Card)/ USA citizen).

Desired qualifications and skill set:

- Experience in teaching of Indian classical music such as Dhrupad, Khayal, Thumri, Tappa, Tarana, Dadra, Kriti, Varnam, Padam, Javali, Tillana and others.
- Comprehensive understanding of computer operations, encompassing audio/video recording and downloading, as well as video mixing and editing from online platforms such as YouTube and the internet.
- Demonstrated experience in delivering performance and lecture demonstrations.
- Aptitude for producing stage programs and choreography, along with expertise in examination preparation.
- The candidate should exhibit initiative and dedication towards assisting students in reaching their highest potential, maintaining high expectations for achievement, progress, and conduct.
