TENDER NOTICE

Bids are invited towards purchase and secured installation of CCTV system having 26 camera Network Video Recorder (NVR) CCTV system (with at least 45 days recording) to be installed across two floors (01st and 11th floor) at 1015, 2nd Avenue, Seattle, for new premise of Consulate General of India, Seattle, WA. Camera design should be 4 MP or better Dome Varifocal and preferably Wide FOV (Field of View) – NVR Security Camera. 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Chapter I - Tender Details and General Instructions

Bids containing **Technical Bid** and **Financial Bid** for contract (bid validity at least for next three months) from experienced & registered firms, complete in all respects should be submitted to the Head of Chancery, Consulate General of India, Seattle at 1015 2nd Avenue, Seattle, WA 98104 in order to reach before the deadline of 1700 hrs. on 10 October 2024. The submitted Bids should clearly carry the subject line “Bid for Purchase and Installation of CCTV system for CGI Seattle. All tenders received after the deadline will be summarily rejected.

2. All bidders should submit along with the Tender the following documents:
 - i. Separate bids in the prescribed Technical Bid Document and Financial Bid Document (proformas attached in chapter II and III).
 - ii. Both the above documents must be signed by authorized signatories of the bidding firm with a seal / stamp.
 - iii. Self-attested photo-copy of registration of the company /firm proprietorship with the concerned authorities.
 - iv. Annual Report (where statutorily required to be filled).
 - v. Details of experience in the field of CCTV security installations with Embassies and Consulates/reputed Companies/Government agencies, etc.

N.B.: It must be noted that the bid must include all aspect related to installation of CCTV system as per specifications provided, including purchase of the CCTV system, associated equipments, installation, etc which is to be done at new premise of the Consulate General of India, Seattle on 11th and 01th floor of 1015, 2nd Avenue, Seattle-98104.

4. VIDEO MANAGEMENT SOFTWARE

<u>S. No</u>	<u>Specifications</u>
1.	Supply of video surveillance application software/video management software (VMS) for NVR to be provided with camera licenses suitable for all ONVIF cameras with full functionality, virtual matrix capability.
2.	VMS should have inbuilt facility to store configuration of cameras.
3.	VMS shall support flexible 1/4/8/16/26 user defined windows split screen display mode or scroll mode on the PC/Workstation monitor or on preview monitor as per site requirement.
4.	VMS shall be able to control all cameras features such as PTZ control, iris control, auto/manual focus, and color balance of camera, selection of presets, video tour selection etc.
5.	VMS should be able to generate reports of stored device configuration. The software should provide alarm and alarm logs. The configuration shall be able to be archived, printed and displayed.
6.	VMS should provide user activity log (audit trail) with user id, time stamp, and action performed, etc.
7.	The administrator shall be able to add, edit & delete users with rights. It shall be possible to view ability/rights of each user or the cameras which can be viewed & controlled as per the permission assigned by the administrator.
8.	VMS shall provide a facility for any alarm input initiating any action in the VMS system.
9.	VMS shall provide intrusion detection, motion detection and security device alarm etc as per site requirement.
10.	VMS should provide a reporting utility for tracking but not limited to alarms, incidents, operator logs, service requests etc. Video and images shall be stored with reports for documenting events.
11.	VMS should have capability for integration with other security equipment such as fire alarm/panel etc.

5. In addition, following aspect should be followed by the participating bidders:

The bidder should be a company or firm duly registered with the concerned authorities in the USA and must not be blacklisted by Governments of USA or India for poor performance in the past. Bidder must be a firm with a past record of providing CCTV security installations in the USA. Consulate General of India, Seattle reserves the right to reject bids from firms who do not have adequate experience in the field of security services.

The bids will remain valid for at least 3 months from tender closing, for award of contract after obtaining approval of competent Indian authorities. No price escalation would be allowed. **All rates and sum inserted against items of works shall be exclusive of Value Added Tax (TVA).**

The successful bidder has to sign a contract with the Consulate General of India, Seattle in an appropriate form for execution of the contract.

First the Technical bid will be opened and the pre-qualification of the bidder will be assessed and then financial document of only those bidder [s] who meet the technical criterion will be opened.

The winning bidder would be required to dedicate one supervisor /manager who can be contacted for all queries / requirements.

Installation & Commissioning, Supervision and Demonstration of the goods: Providing required jigs and tools for assembly, all works required for the completion of the installation. It is reiterated that the bid must include all aspect related to installation of CCTV system as per specifications provided, including purchase of the CCTV system, associated equipments, installation, etc which is to be done at new premise of the Consulate General of India, Seattle on 01st and 11th Floor, 1015, 2nd Avenue, Seattle.

After Sales Service: After sales service centre should be available on 24 (hrs.) X 7 (days) X 365 (days) basis. Complaints should be attended properly, maximum within 24 hrs to ensure an uptime of minimum 95%, wherever applicable.

Guarantee / Warrantee Period: The Tenderer has to indicate the guarantee/ warrantee period of the CCTV system.
